

EAST POST ROAD BRIDGE ELEMENT PREFERENCE SURVEY

Introduction

As part of the September 30, 2008, neighborhood meeting, a range of ideas/concepts regarding various visible parts of the bridge were presented for comment (Preference Survey) by those in attendance. From the information provided, ideas for the railings, lighting and exterior surface treatments were narrowed to those being displayed this evening. The bridge design team is once again asking for your input relative to which of the combinations of railing ideas, exterior surface ideas and lighting ideas you prefer.

The combined ideas presented represent putting together the top vote getters in each of the categories.

For the railing and surface treatment elements the alternatives provided are various combinations of the top TWO vote getters from the September 30 neighborhood meeting, while only the lighting idea receiving highest preference vote is included. Only one light idea is being included because it received more votes than the other ideas and it is a light that the city already has in place, which will improve the cost effectiveness of the light.



Preference Survey

In the displays area there are graphics of the various combinations of surface treatments and railings.

The city would like your opinion as to which of the examples, if any, you would prefer for the East Post Road Bridge.

Using the colored dots on this sheet, note your preference of each combination of elements by placing tape dots on the examples you like the most:

- Red Dot: Highest preference/like it the most
- Green Dot: Second highest preference
- Yellow Dot: Third preference
- Blue Dot: Fourth preference

Please do not place more than one dot per individual item. You do not have to use all your dots if you do not have a preference of one idea over another.
